Virtual Conference Center to Open July 18

“The PangeAir Gateway,” a state-of-the-art teleconference facility, will open at the Dayton Convention Center on July 18. It will be available to rent for meetings, as a training and education facility and for special events.

The suite on the Convention Center’s first floor will accommodate up to 25 participants and offer high-definition interactive video on two 65-inch LCD screens.

The Dayton PangeAir Gateway is the first franchise of Indianapolis-based PangeAir Corporation, a company launching a network of public access, rentable teleconferencing services, and is owned by Dayton-area entrepreneur David Allen, who has also developed patented telepresence and videoconferencing technologies.

PangeAir CEO Bob Briggs said the Dayton Convention Center is the logical place for a virtual conference and education center.

“Businesses and organizations can bring together distant employees, executives and clients without the challenges of long distance travel in an environment that can best be described as interactive high-definition TV,” Briggs said.
