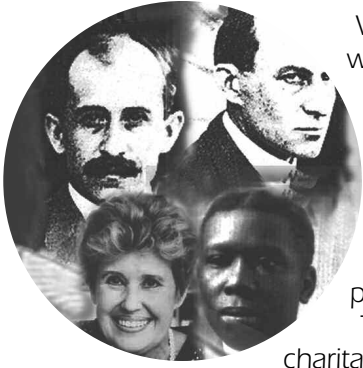


Mayor McLin's 4th Annual Heritage Community Service Program

Volunteers are important to the City of Dayton. There are multiple values created by volunteer work—value to the agency, its clients, the community, and the volunteer. Mayor Rhine McLin is encouraging individuals to participate in the Heritage Community Service Program and commit to a level of ownership for the success of our city and region.

Program participants must contribute at **least 50** hours of volunteer service within the City during 2008. During the first quarter of 2009, volunteerism will be celebrated and Mayor McLin will recognize all of the successful participants with a "Heritage Certificate." Businesses, organizations, and schools are asked to encourage their volunteers to use this program as an added incentive.

Types of community service efforts could include volunteering through social services agencies, charitable organizations, recreation centers, senior citizen centers, or other avenues that serve the community.
